TASTING NOTES**PLATAS (SILVER)**

Herradura: lots of personality, with sharp peppery flavors.
Patrón: Simple, smooth, sippable.

REPOSADOS (GOLD)

Cuervo Traditional: warm, golden, satisfying (squirt of lime juice perks up flavors).

ANEJOS

El Tesoro: medium body, complex licorice/ginger flavors.
Souzo Tres Generaciones: syrupy, with rich aromas reminiscent of honey and ripe pineapple.

PREMIUM ANEJOS

Porfidio Single Barrel "Cactus": creamy, full-bodied, subtle, with a sweet, almost butterscotchy flavor.
Chinaco: rolls across palate like silk.

MEZCAL

Del Maguey Single Village Santo Domingo Albaradas: full-bodied, smoky aromas, leaves hint of caraway flavor on tongue.

CORRALEJO REPOSADO

Smooth, complex, with beguiling impressions of peaches, pine nuts, vanilla and, odd as this may sound, a lingering aftertaste resembling creme brûlée. Our tasting panel loved this one.

CABO WABO REPOSADO

First impression is of refreshing floral/vegetal aromas, followed by a mysterious smoky quality. Swirl in a snifter, sip slowly and savor the intricate personality of this stunner.
